- 1. 1996/1997 & 2005/2006- NZ TA costed over \$300k
- 2. Government decided:
 - Ownership/context fit of the program = Developed it ourselves
 - Compulsory/Not voluntary
 - costed us just over \$75K [including Consultations & Workshops] 3 years work
- 4. Accreditation Program:
 - Rolled out in 2015/2016
 - Information collection exercise
 - Review & Amendments


